It was a strange winter, with negative wind chills, minor snow events and then some crazy warm temps. But now is the time to shed our coats and look forward to a great spring and summer.

The Wyomissing Recreation Board is happy to announce a new Recreation Management software and website. Now, instead of having to fill out multiple online forms for different activities and programs, you will be able to create an account with all the members of your household in one location. You can register kids for playground, swimming lessons, tennis lessons, rent the Stone House or Pavilion at the Hills, and purchase your pool membership with just a few clicks. You can pay online with credit card, (without a convenience fee), or have an invoice emailed directly to you and then send in payment or bring invoice to Borough Hall for processing. We will also use this for email alerts and announcements regarding programs and events.

With Easter falling on April 21st, the same weekend we would normally hold our Earth Day Fair, we have decided to put the event on the shelf for this year and come back to it next April. The Egg Hunt will be on Saturday April 13th. The annual Fishing Rodeo will take place on Saturday May 11th down at the Wyomissing Creek behind the Stone House. The Memorial Day Parade and Ceremony will be held on Saturday May 25th over at Wyomissing

Hills Memorial Park. We encourage all Borough Residents to join us at this important event to remember those who made the ultimate sacrifice.

We will again be offering a concert and movie at Wyomissing Hills Memorial Park to kick off the summer on Friday May 31st, presented by the Wyomissing Hills Social Committee. Last year's event was great! The Wyomissing Band will perform classic movie theme music and then the movie will follow. Note: When available, choose Pay Online to be placed in an activity immediately or placed on wait list. Choosing Print Registration Form will not place you into an activity until the form is processed by the office, along with payment if required.

All children must be registered and the fee paid before participating.

The program is for Borough residents only.

Children must be 4 by September 1 to participate in Tot Lot.

The Playground program is for children 7 through 13. Children must be 7 by September 1 to participate in Playground. No Exceptions.

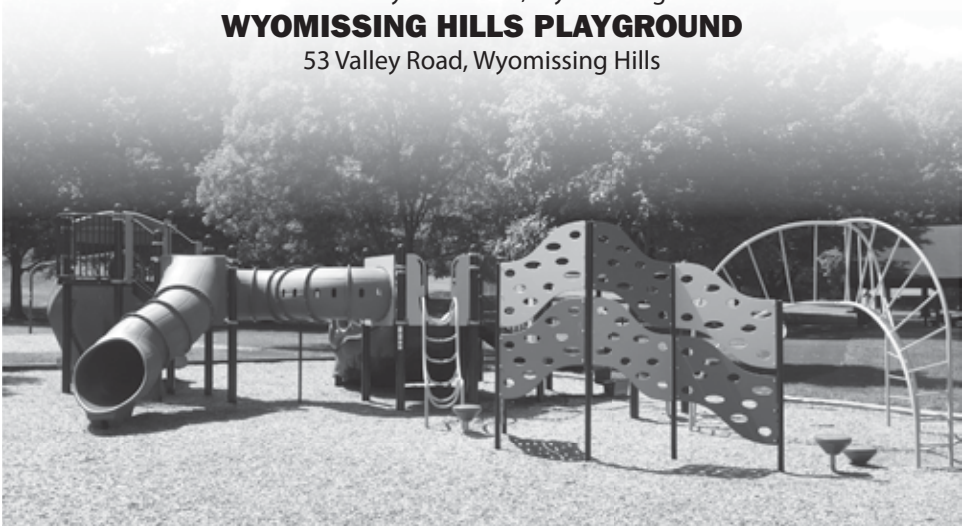
Playground activities will include tee-ball, kickball, basketball, box hockey, storytelling, arts and crafts, tot lot, and more.

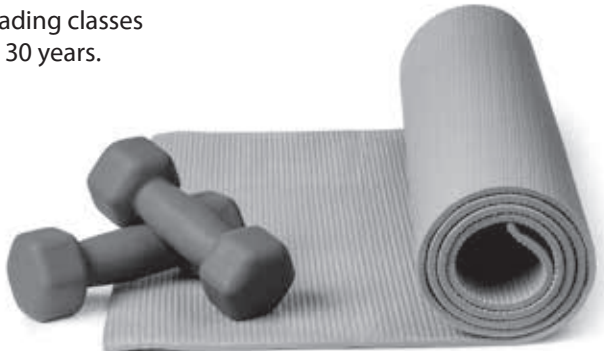

Memberships will also be on sale at the pool, May 23rd/24th — 3:30 PM to 6:30 PM. Person purchasing membership must be 18 years or older and proof of residency is required. Proof of age is required at time of registration for 60 Plus Club. Once the pool opens, memberships are sold only at the pool or online. You may bring check or cash on your first visit and register at that time. Credit Card payments will be accepted only at the Borough Hall during business hours, however you must register at the pool first.

SWIMMING LESSONS

1. There will be (3) two-week instructional swimming periods. All sessions will be held Monday through Friday.
2. Those who register for classes are expected to attend regularly or drop out of the class. It is not fair to the instructor or the other members of the class if someone's attendance is irregular.
3. Registration can be made at the pool or online.
4. Registration fee: \$50.00 (member)
\$60.00 (resident non-member).
5. Swimming Lessons are non-refundable
6. Only those individuals participating in the instruction are permitted in the pool during instruction periods. All parents must stay above the deck area during this period.
7. Registration is limited to one swim session per child per summer. However, the same child may enroll in a second session at a later date, if there is a vacancy. The procedure for this is to request that your name be placed on a stand-by list.

Mandatory meeting for all swim team parents at 6:00 PM. 8 and under need to swim freestyle for 25 consecutive meters. 9 and above need to swim freestyle for 50 consecutive meters. \$40.00 registration fee, (swimmers must be a member of the Wyomissing pool according to BCSEA rules). Practices are held daily M-F from 8:15-12:00 and meets are held on Monday evenings between June and the end of July.

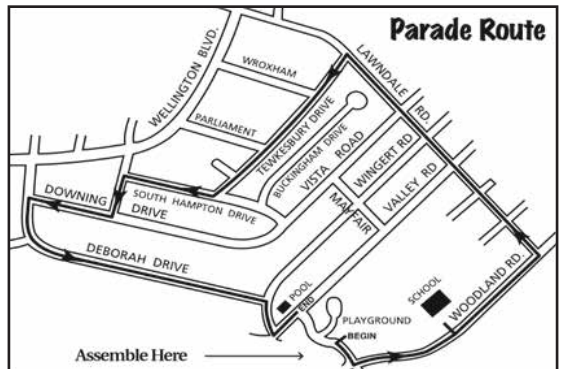

On Saturday, May 25th we will once again come together as a community to reflect on all those who have given the ultimate sacrifice for our Country. Join us for our annual Memorial Day Parade and Memorial Ceremony at Wyomissing Hills Memorial Park and Playground. **This year's Memorial Day Parade and Celebration is dedicated to M. Lila Bertolet.** Lila was employed by Wyomissing Hills for over 21 years as the Borough Secretary, Treasurer and Office Manager. When she retired, she was appointed and then elected as a Councilwoman, serving on the Police and Fire, and Shade Tree Committees, and as chairperson of the Personnel and Special Events Committee. Lila admittedly "loved a parade," and in 1996, she started and was chairwoman of the Wyomissing Hills Memorial Day Parade, a position she held for nine years, and an annual tradition that continues today.

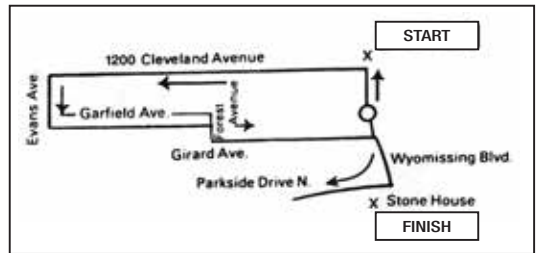

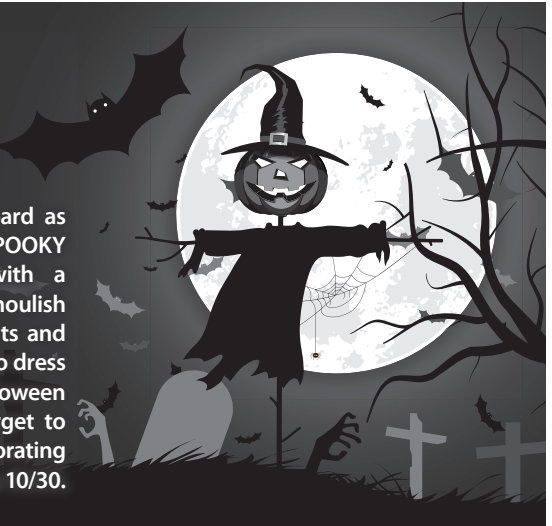
