RENTAL INFO

Thank you for your interest in renting one of our Borough Recreation facilities. Unfortunately, in following our Parks and Recreation Reopening Plan, we will not rent Recreation Facilities until Berks County moves into the "Phase-Out" portion of our plan. We encourage you to visit our website at www.wyomissingrec.com for updates.

The Stone House and Pavilion Rentals

The Stone House and the pavilions at Happy Hollow and Wyomissing Hills playgrounds are available to rent for all Borough Residents, for parties, meetings, or reunions. The Wyomissing Pool is also available to rent for parties.

A non-refundable fee is required to reserve the facilities. Reservations should be made at least three weeks in advance by going to WyomissingRec.com, to check for availability and make a reservation. Reservations are on a first come, first served basis. Alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, and glass containers are not permitted at any Recreational facility.

FACILITY FAQ's

Q: Do you have to be a Wyomissing Borough resident to rent the facilities?

A: Yes, we only allow our residents to rent our facilities.

Q: How long do I have the facility?

A: When a facility is rented, you have it the entire day. You may NOT set up the day before. At the end of the day, ALL clean up must be taken care of as someone else may have it the following day.

Q: Are there grills at any locations?

A: No, grills are not provided. We do allow you to bring your own gas grill. You are responsible for making sure it is attended to at all times as well as removing it from the facility at the same time you leave. PLEASE make sure the grill is a safe distance away from the facility when in use.

Q: Are you allowed to bring any tents or bouncy houses/ inflatables?

A: No, we do NOT allow any type of tents or inflatables due to a liability concern.

Q: When is my key to be picked up and returned?

A: If the event is during the week, the key is to be picked up the day before. If the event is on the weekend it is to be picked up Friday unless it is a holiday. ALL keys are due back the following business day. If the key is not returned the following business day, we will keep the \$20 key deposit.

Q: What is expected of me when leaving the facility?

A: Trash is to be put in proper receptacles, the facility is to be cleaned thoroughly, and the bathrooms/facility are to be locked up properly.



HOW TO CREATE AN ACCOUNT

How to Create an Account on WyomissingRec.com

Creating an account is a one-time event that allows you to utilize this system. It is not a registration by itself.

1. Enter the primary adult first.
2. Add other members of your household from the Account Members portion of your account.
3. You can now make registrations and other purchases using the site navigation.



If you have previously made an account and cannot log in, please reset your password or contact us instead of creating a new account. Only one account can be created for each household. Please enter actual birthdays as some activities are age specific.

Please note: Once you create your account, our staff will have to approve the account before any activities, memberships, or facility reservations are made. We may email you and request that you send us proof of residency via email to confirm your address.

Digital Membership Cards are now available for use with valid pool memberships. For information on how to retrieve your digital membership card, visit the home page at www.wyomissingrec.com and click on Digital Membership Cards!

Borough residents will now be able to use their Wyomissing Rec accounts to pay for pool day passes, guest passes and all food items at the snack bar! For more information, ask our amazing pool front desk staff how you can set up a "Fund Account" anytime during normal operating pool hours.

Day to Remember and Reflect

On Saturday, May 28th we will once again come together as a community to reflect on all those who have given the ultimate sacrifice for our Country. Join us for our annual Memorial Day Parade and Memorial Ceremony at Wyomissing Hills Memorial Park and Playground.

This year's Grand Marshal is Bill Galvin, a resident of Wyomissing Hills.

Bill graduated from the United States Military Academy at West Point in 2005 and was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in Field Artillery. He served with the 1st Cavalry Division out of Fort Hood, Texas and deployed to Baghdad, Iraq in 2006 in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. As a Platoon Leader, he led and conducted over 300 combat missions during his 15 month deployment. After his promotion to Captain, he took command of a Basic Training Unit at Fort Sill, Oklahoma where he led and helped prepare 900 soldiers for their first assignments. He earned many military honors including a Bronze Star. Bill's father and his 3 siblings and their spouses are also Army veterans.

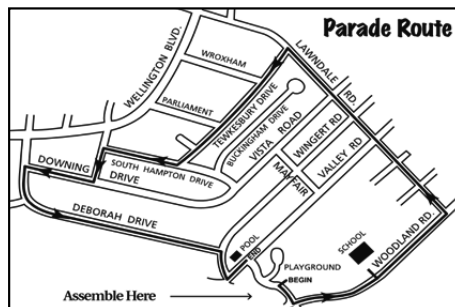
After his military service, Bill pursued a career in business while also earning an MBA. He then took on his toughest assignment yet: A Stay-At-Home Dad to 4 young children during a global pandemic. During this time, he realized he wanted to serve his community again and train the next generation of young leaders. He is excited to begin his new journey in the classroom as an elementary teacher this fall.

There will be a ribbon cutting ceremony for our newly refurbished war memorial prior to the start of memorial ceremony. Thank you to New Castle Lawn and Landscape for donating their time and materials to this project.

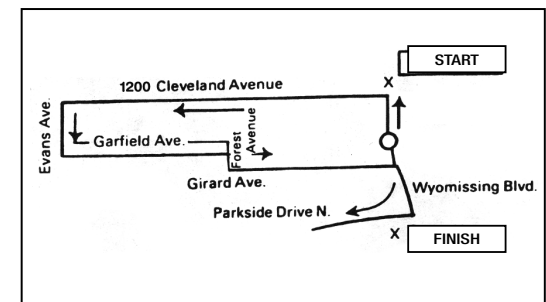

There are two (2) options to register for the program:

Note: When available, choose Pay Online to be placed in an activity immediately or placed on wait list. Choosing Print Registration Form will not place you into an activity until the form is processed by the office, along with payment if required.

All children must be registered and the fee paid before participating.

The program is for Borough residents only.

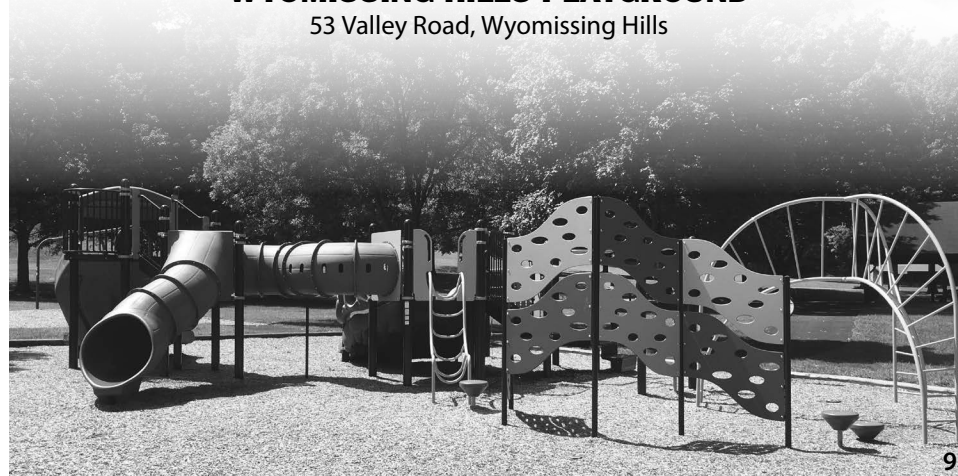

SWIM LESSONS, SWIM TEAM & SWIMNASTICS

Swimming Lessons

1. There will be (3) two-week instructional swimming periods. All sessions will be held Monday through Friday.
2. Those who register for classes are expected to attend regularly or drop out of the class. It is not fair to the instructor or the other members of the class if someone's attendance is irregular.
3. Registration can be made at the pool or online.
4. Registration fee: \$115.00 (member)
\$125.00 (resident non-member).
5. Swimming Lessons are non-refundable
6. Only those individuals participating in the instruction are permitted in the pool during instruction periods. All parents must stay above the deck area during this period.
7. Registration is limited to one swim session per child per summer. However, the same child may enroll in a second session at a later date, if there is a vacancy. The procedure for this is to request that your name be placed on a stand-by list.

Competitive swimming is available to Borough residents of all ages who are pool members. Swim Team Contact Kate Fanning at sallysingalong62@gmail.com or Coach Scott Williams at sbwilliams2@comcast.net. Registration for swim team will be held on Tuesday, May 10th at the Wyomissing Library at 5:30 PM. Swimsuit orders will be taken during this time. Mandatory meeting for all swim team parents at 6:00 PM. Children 8 and under need to swim freestyle for 25 consecutive meters. Children 9 and above need to swim freestyle for 50 consecutive meters. Swimmers must be a member of the Wyomissing pool according to BCSA rules. Practices are held daily M-F from 8:15 AM - 12:00 PM (age group will determine specific time) and meets are held on Monday evenings between June and the end of July.

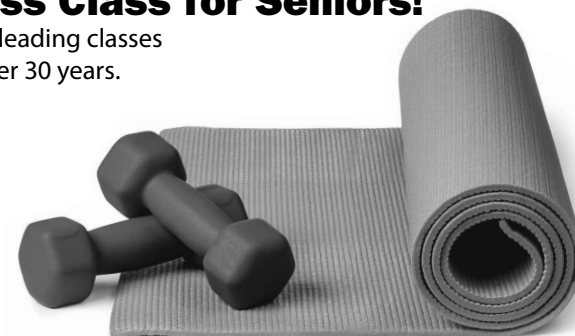

Ice skating is permitted when the ice is at least two inches thick. Hours of operation are 7:00 A.M – 9:30 P.M. Perimeter lights will be on from 4:00 P.M – 9:30 P.M.

Signs posted around the perimeter of the pond as well as Borough website and social media postings will signify weather skating is permitted or not.

Follow these guidelines to ensure everyone has a safe and fun experience:

- Stay OFF the ice until Borough staff gives the “all clear” for skating.
- Keep debris such as rocks and sticks off the ice surface.
- Stay off the ice if it is thin and cracking.
- Monitor small children on the ice at all times.
