RENTAL INFORMATION

Explore the possibilities of hosting your events at some of Wyomissing's most delightful facilities. The Stone House, and Pavilions at Happy Hollow and Wyomissing Hills Playgrounds are available for rent to all Borough residents, providing ideal settings for parties, meetings, or reunions. Additionally, the Wyomissing Pool and Pool Pavilion are open for private rentals for additional summer fun.

To reserve your desired date and facility, a refundable \$100.00 deposit is required, and reservations should be made at least two weeks in advance. Check **WyomissingREC.com** for availability and to make your reservation on a first-come, first-served basis. Please note that alcoholic beverages, illegal substances, and glass containers are strictly prohibited at any recreational facility.

FACILITY FAQs



Q: How do I go about renting one of the Borough's facilities?

A: Visit WyomissingREC.com and click on the RESERVE icon on the navigation bar, then follow the prompts to initiate the rental process.

Q: Is facility rental limited to Wyomissing Borough residents only?

A: Yes, facility rental is exclusive to Wyomissing Borough residents.

Q: How long is the facility available for rental?

A: When rented, the facility is reserved for the entire day. Setup the day before is not permitted. Clean-up is the responsibility of the renter at the end of the event to ensure readiness for the next reservation.

Q: When and where do I pick up the keys, and when should I return the keys?

A: For weekday events, pick up the key the day before. For weekend events, pick up on Friday (unless it's a holiday). Keys can be picked up at the receptionist desk at Borough Hall, located at 22 Reading Boulevard, Wyomissing. Keys must be placed in the black drop box at the facility upon completion of rental.

Q: Are grills provided at the locations?

A: No, grills are not provided. You may bring your own gas grill, but it must be attended to at all times and removed from the facility after use. Please ensure a safe distance from the facility during operation.

Q: Can I bring tents or inflatables?

A: No, for liability reasons, tents and inflatables are not permitted.

Q: What is required upon leaving the facility?

A: Dispose of trash in designated receptacles, thoroughly clean the facility, and ensure proper closure, including locking bathrooms and the facility itself. Our staff will conduct a walkthrough to ensure all policies and rules were followed and that the facility is left in good, clean condition.

THE PARKLANDS OF WYOMISSING BOROUGH

Wyomissing has a rich history, once inhabited by Native Americans from the Lenni Lenape tribe along the banks of Wyomissing Creek.

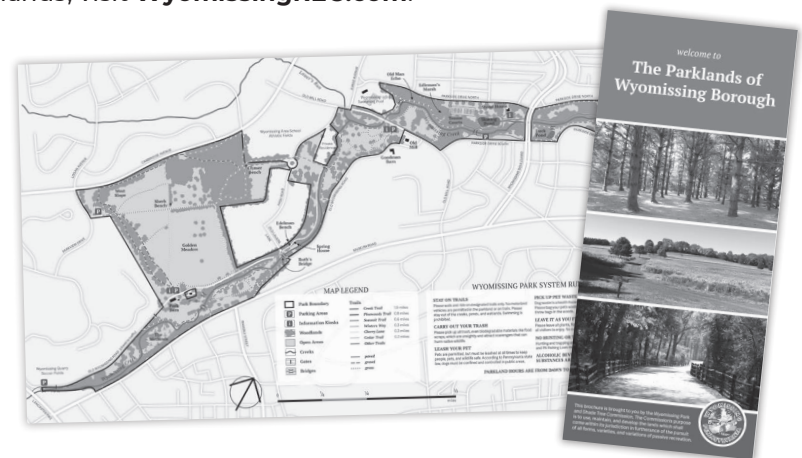
The name "Wyomissing" is believed to mean "a place of flats," capturing the area's flat terrain. Unique to the Borough is the strategic preservation of open spaces within residential areas. In 1929, founder Ferdinand Thun secured and preserved land along both sides of the creek, later designated as parkland in the 1970s.

The extensive trail network, composed of paved, stone, and grass paths, offers both short and long excursions, allowing residents to traverse the Borough from the Reading Museum to The Highlands. The trails follow the picturesque Wyomissing Creek, leading to meadows, piney woods, and landmarks like Old Man Echo.

Throughout the year, diverse plant life, including snowdrops, skunk cabbage, wildflowers, and blossoms, adorns the landscape, complemented by lush meadows and forests. The parklands are a haven for wildlife, hosting deer, eagles, brown trout, painted turtles, and various freshwater invertebrates in the Wyomissing Creek.

In the words of 16th-century physician Paracelsus, "The art of healing comes from nature, not from the physician." Wyomissing Parklands provide a natural connection proven to alleviate stress, strengthen relationships, and enhance mental well-being.

DID YOU KNOW?

Wyomissing’s love for recreation and community spirit has deep roots, going all the way back to April 10, 1910. It was on this day that a lively meeting took place at the Borough Hall, where enthusiastic speakers shared a bold vision for a public recreation area. The outcome? A newly elected committee and the birth of the Playground Association—an organization with a forward-thinking mission: to “promote the playground interests of the town and foster close cooperation between the home, the school, and the playground.”

By May 16, 1910, the hunt was on to find the perfect spot for Wyomissing’s playground. After surveying the borough, a location was chosen, bordered by Terrace, Lynn, Garfield, and Trent Avenues. Some of this land was already owned by the Board of Education, which sparked an innovative partnership between the Playground Association and the School District—an arrangement that would become the backbone of the playground’s success.



DID YOU KNOW?

With the community rallying together, private donations poured in, and by July 4, 1910, Wyomissing proudly celebrated the grand opening of the brand-new Happy Hollow Playground. From croquet courts in 1911 to a merry-go-round, see-saws, and athletic equipment by 1914, the playground quickly became the place to be.

Though World War I temporarily halted improvements, the Roaring Twenties brought new energy to the Playground Association. Backed by school tax funding, the playground grew by leaps and bounds, adding quoit courts, a pavilion, tennis courts, and even a handball court between 1922 and 1925. Not stopping there, in 1926, a new swimming pool was opened across Trent Avenue at Wayne Avenue, making summer days even better.

The 1930s brought even more charm, with the construction of a second pavilion and a packed calendar of events. Happy Hollow became the beating heart of Wyomissing’s social life, hosting everything from summer programs for kids to picnics, festivals, sporting events, and even dances that had everyone—from kids to grandparents—swinging the night away.

Fast forward over a century, and the Happy Hollow Playground remains a cherished gem in Wyomissing. It’s more than just a park; it’s a gathering place where generations have laughed, played, and celebrated life’s milestones. Today, Happy Hollow is still buzzing with activity, hosting a variety of events, programs, and family-friendly fun year-round.

Whether you’re joining a summer event, strolling the grounds, or watching your kids create memories of their own, Happy Hollow is a testament to the spirit of Wyomissing—a place where community, tradition, and joy come together in perfect harmony.
